History

Develop a chronological understanding of events and the words/phrases related to the passing of time. Roald Dahl biography. Ancient, non-European study - the Mayans. History of Chocolate.

Science

Animals, including humans need the right types and amounts of nutrition; they get nutrition from what they eat. Identify that humans and some animals have a skeleton and muscles for protection and movement. Consider and compare Mr Fox and the farmers. Recognise that we need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light. Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object
