

English

Our texts this term are: Fables, Autobiographies and Adventure stories (book study). We shall continue with guided reading activities and separate SPAG and handwriting activities.

Computing Skills

We aim to look at E-Safety and how to use technology safely & keep personal information private.

Use Mathletics at home to help with quick recall of number facts!

Use the Tackling Tables cards or app at home to 'learn, play & test' blue phase multiplication & division.

Art & Design

Manga – to look at Japanese art form and to draw in the anime style developing into a storybook based on manga.

History

We shall continue, from last term, looking at Ancient Greece.

Languages – German

To learn words about food, animals, places and greetings.

Science

Evolution: To recognise how living things have changed over time. Identify how animals and plants adapt to suit their environment. **Light:** To recognise that light travels in straight line. (Linked with reflection and shadows). **Electricity** – the journey. Recognise symbols when representing a circuit in a diagram. Look at changes to power.

PSHE (Personal, Social & Health Education)

PE (Physical Education)

Geography

Investigating rivers – to look at the journey of rivers from source to sea.
