- **Welcome to new School Council Members:** All new School Council members were welcomed to the meeting and given their new School Council badges.
- **Behaviour at our school:** Following on from the responses from the Pupil questionnaire, children were asked to share their views about behaviour at our school. The sorts of behaviour that children said they didn't like were:
 - when children shout out, don't listen or are disrespectful to others,
 - when children are unkind or mean to others,
 - when children push, hurt or are too physical with others.

Particular mention was made of children not looking after sports / playground equipment as well as they should. They also disliked a particular game where children push others off the tyres.

- **What we can do to help:** School Council discussed what we can all do to help and how we can be role models and lead by example/show others what they should be doing. We also talked about how people make mistakes and how we all should try our best to 'do the right thing' when we make a mistake e.g. say sorry and try our best not to keep repeating our mistakes but to learn from them instead.
- **Languages:** We talked about how exciting it is that all classes are now learning a new language. Each Year group spoke enthusiastically about what they have learned already and how much they are all enjoying their learning.
 - Year One are learning Sign Language,
 - Year 2 – Spanish,
 - Year 3 – French,
 - Year 4 – Mandarin,
 - Year 5 - Italian and
 - Year 6 - German.
- Mrs Luebcke was very impressed by the enthusiasm for Languages shown by all of the children and was amazed by how much they had absorbed in just a few weeks!
- We finished the meeting with a photograph of all of the School Council for our display board in the corridor outside the Year Two classroom.
