

## English

We will be looking at a range of animal themed texts, both fiction and non-fiction. Fiction texts will include 'Rumble in the Jungle' by Giles Andreae and 'Dr K Fisher' by Claire Llewellyn. We will look at a variety of information texts and how they differ from fiction texts, including key features, e.g., contents page, index, glossary, alphabetical order etc. After half term we will also start to look at traditional tales.

## Computing

We will look at common uses of IT in school and beyond. We will look at how to use the internet and software with a theme of E-Safety that will continue through the year. We will begin to learn how to take and use digital photography.

## History

During this term, we will take part in a Remembrance Service.

Our major History focus will be in the Spring Term.

## Art & Design

Using 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm,' by Henri Rousseau as our stimulus we will look at the use of colour and how we can use different media to create our own animals in different habitats, such as paint and textured collage.

## Visits & Special Events:-

We are hoping to organise a visit to Woburn Safari Park this term – more details to follow.

## Science

We will find out how most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants and how they depend upon one another. We will learn about how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals using the idea of a simple food chain, identify, and name different sources of food.

## PSHE (Personal, Social & Health Education)

Lola the Leopard will be helping us with our listening skills at the start of term. We will talk about our emotions and feelings. We will also look at our rights, rules and responsibilities and cover anti-bullying.

## RE (Religious Education)

We will be thinking about the question: 'Why do Jewish families talk about repentance at New Year?' After half term, we will be thinking about the question: 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians...?'

## Music

We will listen to a range of live and recorded music looking at pulse, rhythm and structure. After the half term, we will be developing an understanding of the melody of a song, with the aim to rehearse and present performances to an audience.

## Mathematics

We will be looking at three blocks of learning; place value, addition and subtraction and shape. We will be building numbers in all sorts of ways to deepen the children's understanding of place value using 'The Steeple Big 5,' alongside a range of equipment, e.g., cubes, straws, coins, number lines etc.

We will be working on number patterns and the quick recall of key number facts, e.g., number bonds to 20, and doubles to 20 etc. Finally, we will look at recognising and naming both 2-D and 3-D shapes and understand how to differentiate between them.

## PE (Physical Education)

We will work on accurate throwing and catching in our Games sessions and skipping skills, in addition to 'Amazing Animals' as our theme in Dance!

## Geography

Can you name the 7 continents of the world and the 5 oceans? Can you look at a map or atlas and find different habitats around the world, e.g., desert, rainforest, ocean, polar habitats?
